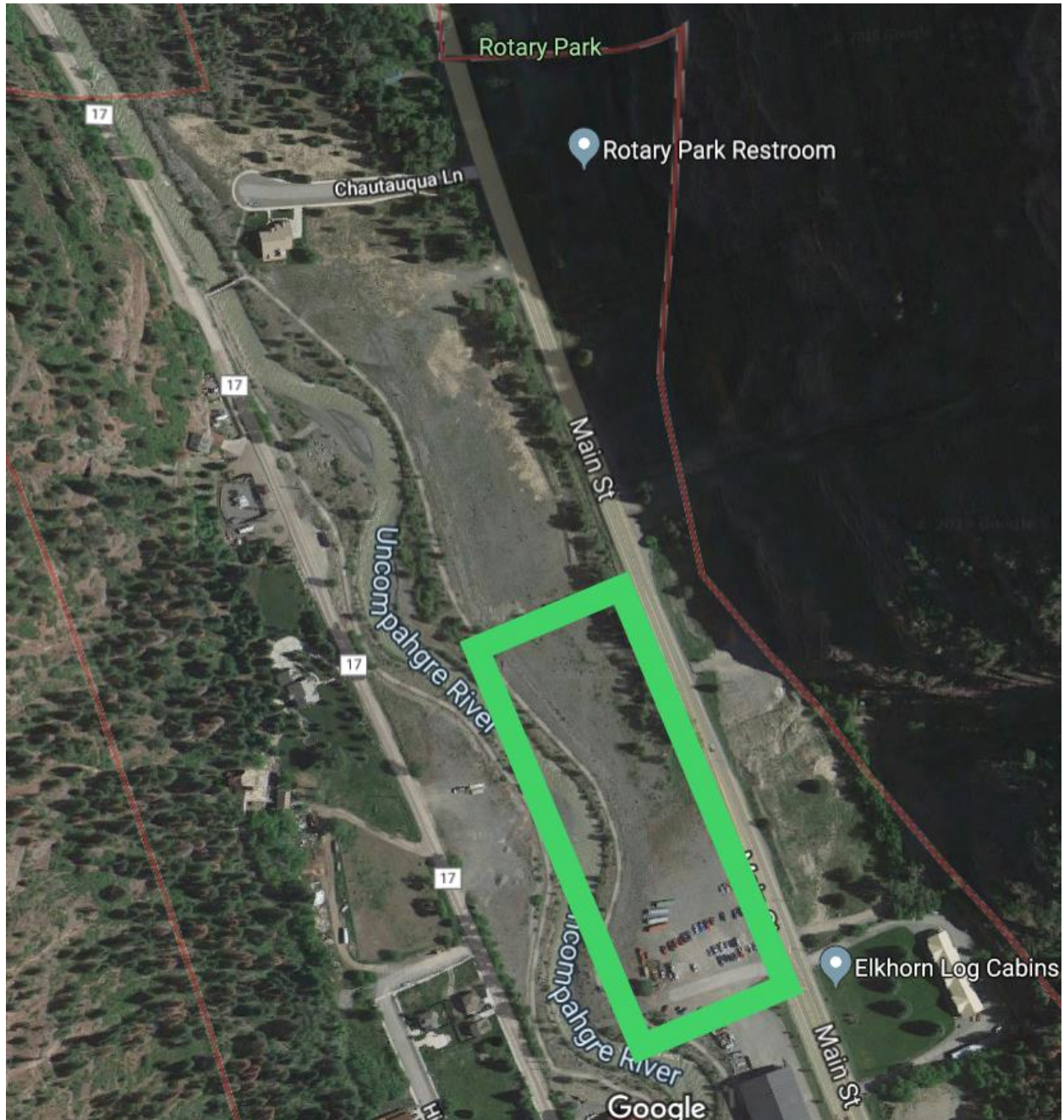

Trail note: Winter 2018/2019 was of historical proportion with some areas seeing 600% of average snowfall. With snow comes avalanches and debris. The incredible depth of snow along with the many areas of avalanche debris have made opening trails very challenging for the local agencies. Some trails will be opening just days prior to our event and some trails likely won't open at all, possibly even all summer. Please have patience with the Rally Staff as we work through closings and adjust the schedule accordingly, mother nature tends to remind us who is in charge on occasion!

- Medium - 2" Lift, oversized tires, some off-road driving experience
- Difficult - 2"+ Lift, oversized tires, rear locker helpful, winch, experience with difficult trails

Equipment Check List

The below list of vehicle prep, required and recommended vehicle items, is not exhaustive and SHOULD NOT be used as a guide for equipment when travelling solo. The below list is adequate when travelling in our sanctioned event trails with our trail leader guides. We will have all the required and recommended equipment in our vehicles as part of our kits.

Vehicle Prep:

Check all fluids
Battery good?
Fuel tank full?
Tire pressures OK?
Location of tire changing equipment?

Required Vehicle Items:

Vehicle recovery point (Most Land Rovers have these from the factory, if you don't know where it is, ask us and we'll show you)
Fire Extinguisher
Spare Tire and jack (check spare air pressure)
Battery tied down
Water - .5 Gal/person
Tire pressure gauge
First Aid Kit

Recommended Vehicle Items:

Recovery equipment (tow strap, snatch block, D-rings)
Winch & Winch controller (locate controller prior to trail)
Leather Gloves
CB or HAM radio
Jacket for rain
Sunscreen
Maps of the area traveling
GPS or compass (Phone app works great)
Flashlight & extra batteries
Snacks or lunch
Camp chair
Bug spray
Tire Sealant kit (Safety Seal or equivalent)
Hi-Lift Jack
Trash bags
Blanket
